Mark gave us a Breakdown on the Cancer Council around Australia and at a state level, QLD main rolls are

- 1- Cancer research.
- 2- Smoking campaign.
- 3- Have six service canthers around Queensland.
- 4- \$30ml collected by fund raising.

In 1984 number of Cancer sufferers 8,200 in 2014- 27,000 Diet plays a big part in Cancer occurring.

Bowel Cancer take up 35% screening; Breast Cancer 55% has screenings and the Federal Government supply a PEA test for Bowel Cancer every three years.

Lung Cancer is the greatest killer in Australia and is on the rise and Queensland is the Melanoma capital of the world.

Cancer Council Australia spends \$150ml on research around Australia per year.
